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# CHANGE OF NAME FORM INSTRUCTIONS AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Am I legally required to notify the Board that my name has changed?

Yes. See Md. Code Ann., Health Occupations Article § 8-312(e)(1) and § 8-6A-08(i)(1).

#### When should I notify the Board that my name has changed?

All licensees and certificate-holders should notify the Board of any change in name immediately, but no later than <u>60 days</u> of the change. Md. Code Ann., Health Occupations ("HO") § 8-312(e)(1) ("Each licensee shall notify the Board in writing of any change in the name . . . of the licensee within 60 days after the change occurred."); § 8-6A-08(i)(1) ("Within 60 days after a change has occurred, each certificate holder shall notify the Board in writing of any change in a name . . . .").

## Do I need to submit documentation in order to change my name?

Yes. Pursuant to COMAR 10.27.01.10D(2), you must submit a request to change your name in writing (use attached form) and provide appropriate legal documentation attesting to the change. Appropriate legal documentation includes a marriage certificate/abstract, a divorce decree/dissolution showing name change clause (with judge's signature), or a court record indicating a name change.

#### How do I notify the Board that my name has changed?

You can notify the Board by submitting a Change of Name Form available on the Board's website at namechangeform.pdf by mail, fax, or e-mail.
