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**ORDER LIFTING AND TERMINATING SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF
REGISTERED NURSE LICENSE**

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On January 31, 2022, the Maryland Board of Nursing (“the Board”) issued an “*Order for Summary Suspension of Registered Nurse Pursuant to Section 10-226(c)(2) of the Administrative Procedure Act*” (the “Order”). This Order summarily suspended the license of **Sheila Angeh, License No. R248149**, (the “Respondent”) to practice registered nursing in the State of Maryland, based on the Board’s finding that the public health, safety, or welfare imperatively required emergency action under Md. Code Ann., State Gov’t. § 10-226(c)(2) (2014 Repl. Vol. & 2021 Supp.).

On February 23, 2022, the Board held a show cause hearing to give the Respondent an opportunity to present argument as to why the Board should not continue the summary suspension of her multistate licensure privilege. The Respondent was present at the Show Cause Hearing. The Administrative Prosecutor -Assistant Attorney General, was present at the Show Cause hearing on behalf of the State. After considering oral argument presented at the Show Cause Hearing, the Board determined that it will not continue the summary suspension of the Respondent’s license.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that the public health, safety, or welfare no longer imperatively

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requires emergency action in this case under Md. Code Ann., State Gov't § 10-226(c)(2) (2014 Repl. Vol. & 2021 Supp.).

III. ORDER

Based on the foregoing, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the summary suspension of the Respondent's license, ordered by the Board's January 31, 2022 *Order for Summary Suspension of Registered Nurse License Pursuant to Section 10-226(c)(2) of the Administrative Procedure Act* is **LIFTED AND TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the Respondent's license to practice registered nursing in the State of Maryland is **REINSTATED** without restrictions, subject to further order of the Board; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order of the Maryland Board of Nursing is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions Article §§ 4-101 *et seq.* (2014).
