**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT OF REGISTERED
NURSE LICENSE TO INACTIVE STATUS**

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On April 29, 2013, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the “Board”) issued a “Final Decision Order of Revocation” (the “Revocation Order”), which revoked the license of **Stephanie Gwenelle Freeman** (the “Respondent”) to practice as a registered nurse (“RN”) in the State of Maryland (license number R105687). The revocation of the Respondent’s RN license was based on the Respondent’s arrival to her place of employment under the influence of alcohol and medications, and her practice of nursing while under the influence of alcohol.

II. CONSIDERATION OF REINSTATEMENT APPLICATION

On or about May 4, 2022, the Respondent submitted a request to the Board to reinstate her license to practice as an RN in the State of Maryland to inactive status. In support of her reinstatement request, the Respondent submitted a letter requesting reinstatement, a receipt for a criminal history records check, letters of reference, certificates of completion, information concerning sobriety, and an application for renewal, on which she selected “inactive status.”

The Board has reviewed and considered all information that the Respondent submitted in support of her application for reinstatement of her RN license to inactive status, as well as all additional information in the Respondent’s file. Accordingly, upon consideration of the Respondent’s request, the Board will reinstate the Respondent’s RN license on inactive status.

ORDERED that the license of the Respondent, Stephanie Gwenelle Freeman, to practice registered nursing in the State of Maryland (license number R105687) is **REINSTATED** to **INACTIVE STATUS**; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.* (2019 Repl. Vol.).
