ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING
LICENSE TO INACTIVE STATUS

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

By order dated September 25, 2013, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the “Board”) placed the licensed practical nursing (“LPN”) license of Mabinty Sesay (the “Respondent”), license number LP45433, on probation, based on violations of the Maryland Nurse Practice Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. (“Health Occ.”) § 8-101 *et seq.*, specifically Health Occ. § 8-316(a)(5)(i), (8), (11), and (25) (the “Probation Order”). By order dated March 23, 2016, the Board reprimanded the Respondent’s LPN license and CNA certificate, certificate number A00079633, based on violations of Health Occ. § 8-316(a)(8) and § 8-6A-10(a)(20) and (26) (the “Reprimand Order”). Both the Probation Order and the Reprimand Order required that the Respondent comply with certain terms and conditions as further outlined in the orders. By order dated November 15, 2017, the Board found that the Respondent failed to comply with the terms of the Probation Order and the Reprimand Order and suspended the Respondent’s LPN license and CNA certificate for a minimum of twelve months (the “Suspension Order”).¹

II. CONSIDERATION OF REINSTATEMENT REQUEST

On or about August 26, 2021, the Respondent submitted a request to the Board to reinstate her license to practice as an LPN to inactive status for the purpose of completing a Board-approved

LPN refresher course. In support of her reinstatement request, the Respondent submitted a letter requesting reinstatement, a receipt for a criminal history records check, and an application for renewal. Upon consideration of the Respondent's request and the accompanying documentation, the Board will reinstate the Respondent's LPN license on inactive status for a period of no longer than one (1) year for the limited purpose of completing a Board-approved LPN refresher course.

III. ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the license of the Respondent, Mabinty Sesay, to practice licensed practical nursing in the State of Maryland, license number LP45433, is **REINSTATED** to **INACTIVE STATUS for a period of no longer than ONE (1) YEAR** from the date of this Order for the limited purpose of completing a Board-approved LPN refresher course; and it is further

ORDERED that if the Respondent fails to submit written proof that she successfully completed a Board-approved LPN refresher course within **ONE (1) YEAR** from the date of this Order, this Order shall have no further force and effect, and the Respondent's LPN license will revert back to suspended status; and it is further

ORDERED that if the Respondent submits written proof of successful completion of a Board-approved LPN refresher course within **ONE (1) YEAR** from the date of this Order, the Respondent may submit to the Board, along with written proof of successful completion of the LPN refresher course, a written application and supporting documentation for reinstatement of her LPN license to active status; however, the Board reserves the right to request additional documentation from the Respondent before making a decision, in the Board's discretion, whether or not to reinstate the Respondent's LPN license to active status; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen.
