**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT OF REGISTERED
NURSE LICENSE TO INACTIVE STATUS**

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On April 28, 2009, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the “Board”) issued a “Final Order of Revocation of Registered Nursing License” (the “Revocation Order”), which revoked the license of Trina Mae Ae Kolander (the “Respondent”) to practice as a registered nurse (“RN”), license number R161268, in the State of Maryland. The revocation of the Respondent’s RN license was based on the Respondent’s expulsion from the Safe Practice Program¹.

On or about June 28, 2019, the Respondent submitted a written request to reinstate her license to practice as an RN to inactive status for the purpose of completing a Board-approved nurse refresher course. By order dated November 26, 2019, the Board granted the Respondent’s request and ordered that she complete a Board-approved nurse refresher course within one (1) year. The Respondent failed to complete a Board-approved nurse refresher course within one (1) year. As a result, the Respondent’s license reverted back to revoked status.

II. CONSIDERATION OF REINSTATEMENT APPLICATION

On or about August 25, 2022, the Respondent submitted a request to the Board to reinstate her license to practice as an RN in the State of Maryland to inactive status so she can take a Board-approved RN refresher course. In support of her reinstatement request, the Respondent submitted supporting documentation, including a letter requesting reinstatement, a receipt for a criminal

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history records check, and an application for renewal.

The Board has reviewed and considered all information that the Respondent submitted in support of her application for reinstatement of her RN license to inactive status, as well as all additional information in the Respondent's file. Accordingly, upon consideration of the Respondent's request, the Board will reinstate the Respondent's RN license on inactive status for one (1) year for the Respondent to complete a Board-approved RN refresher course.

III. ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the license of the Respondent, Trina Mae Ae Kolander, to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Maryland, license number R161268, is **REINSTATED** to **INACTIVE STATUS for a period no longer than ONE (1) YEAR** from the date of this Order for the limited purpose of completing a Board-approved RN refresher course; and it is further

ORDERED that if the Respondent fails to submit written proof that she successfully completed a Board-approved RN refresher course within **ONE (1) YEAR** from the date of this Order, this Order shall have no further force and effect, and the Respondent's RN license will revert back to revoked; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.* (2019 Repl. Vol.).
